## A MOMENT OF GRACE IN DIFFICULT TIMES

This week we received a \$10 check for a Mass Intention. It's a rather unusual intention. It comes from a survivor of clergy sexual abuse. This person had participated in the Syracuse Diocese Independent Reconciliation Compensation Program. This program is managed by a panel of people independent of the Church who review allegations and offer compensation on behalf of the Diocese. The Bishop and clergy have no say over this process.

This survivor called Danielle Cummings, the Chancellor of the Diocese to let her know that he had received his check and that he wanted to use the funds to have Masses celebrated in parishes of the diocese for the intention of local clergy who had abused children and for all those who were harmed. The remainder of the settlement was to go to Catholic Charities for their food pantries.

Why did he do this? He told the Chancellor: "there is so much anger, and I understand that, but then what? I hope we return to prayer." Commenting on the Syracuse Diocese's efforts towards reconciliation he said: "I pray that this will bring as many people as possible some good news, a sense of the importance of loving one another as God loves us, and reminders of the power of prayer and value of forgiveness, peace and charity."

This survivor's Mass Intention will be offered here at Assumption on Sunday, October 21, 2018 at 10 AM.
