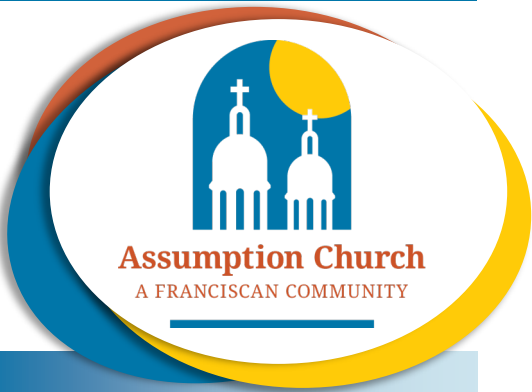

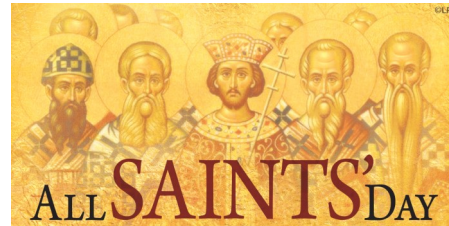

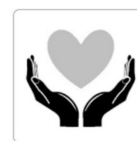
The 12 hours will include:
