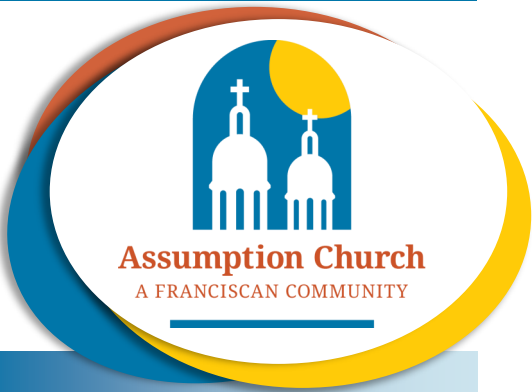

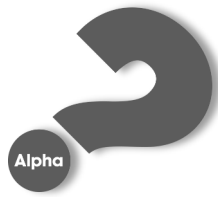

## WALKING WITH SAINT POPE PAUL VI

**What is Evangelization?:** To preach and teach the message of Jesus Christ — this, Pope Paul says, is why the Church exists. But the Church isn't just the "professionals." Pope Paul endorsed Vatican II's forceful reminder that the Church is all of us, the "People of God"! By our witness of the faith where we live, where we work, and where we worship, we realize our vocation of bringing all people to Christ. We evangelize by revealing Christ to others in all that we do. Pope Paul knew that each of us has received this call by virtue of our baptism. It's up to us to trust that God will give us the tools to carry it out.

**Ponder:** Do I consider myself an evangelizer? Do I want to become one?

**Pray:** God of light and courage, help me to trust your trust in me. Remind me always that I am here to share your good news.
