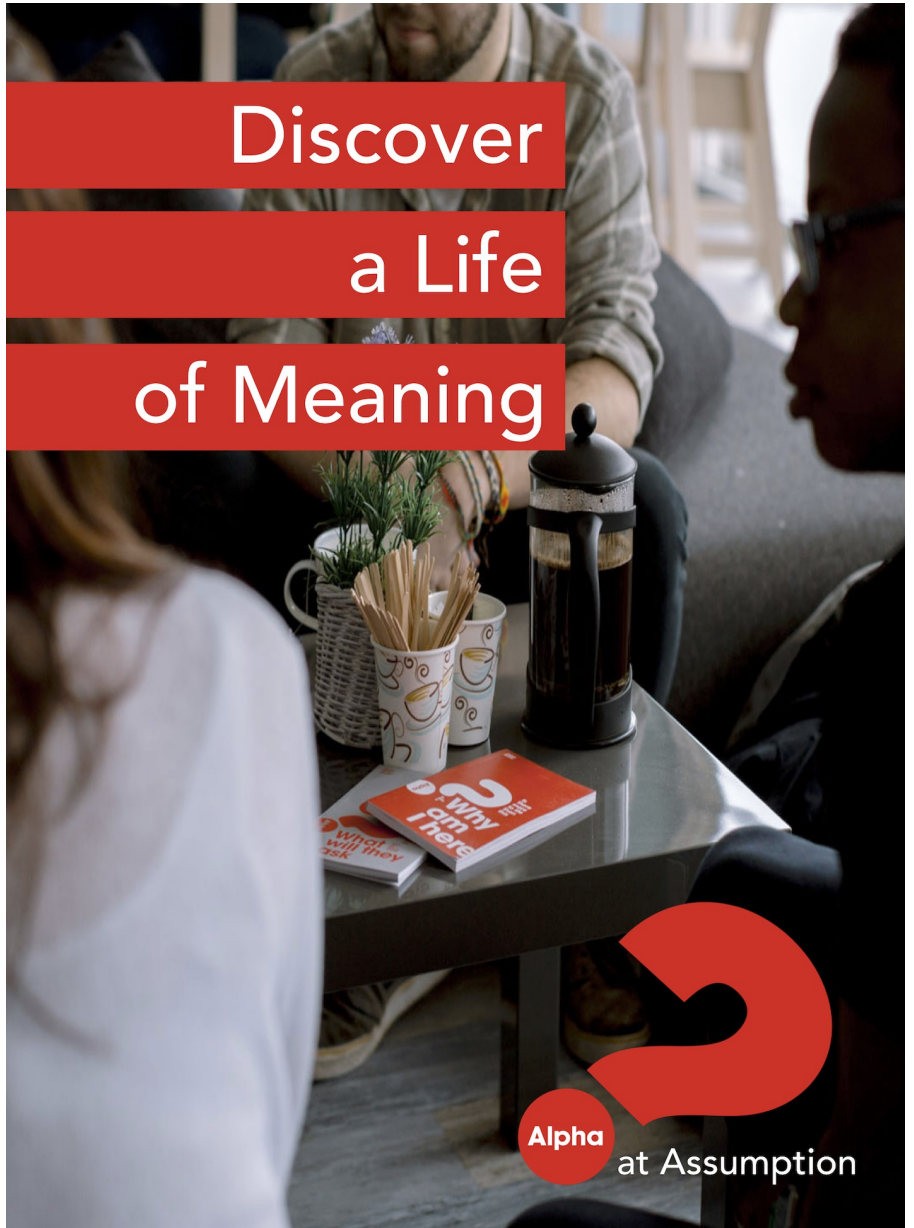

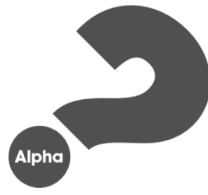
What is the RCIA?

The Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults, or RCIA, is a communal process for formal initiation of new members into the Catholic Church. The U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops describes the RCIA as a process in which participants "undergo . . . conversion as they study the Gospel, profess faith in Jesus and the Catholic Church, and receive the sacraments . . . The RCIA process follows the ancient practice of the Church and was restored by the Second Vatican Council as the normal way adults prepare for baptism." Likewise, the language used in the RCIA process is that of the early church formation programs. Catechumens are those people who are seeking full initiation into the Catholic Church through all of the Sacraments of Initiation – Baptism, Eucharist and Confirmation. Candidates are people who have been baptized in a Christian tradition but are seeking initiation into the Catholic Church through Eucharist and Confirmation or just Confirmation.

The RCIA process is a wonderful journey of faith for Catechumens and Candidates but also for those Catholics who are already fully initiated but would like to expand their knowledge of our rich Catholic traditions.
