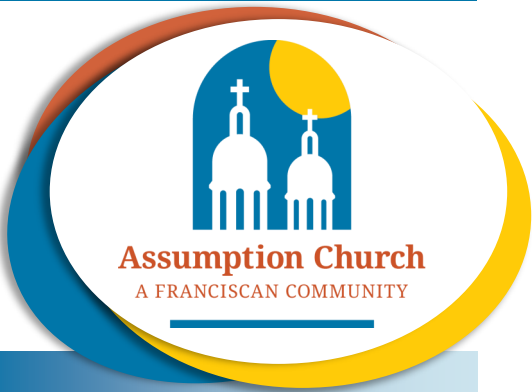

CATHOLIC FAITH 101

The Season of Lent

Lent is a season of forty days, not counting Sundays, which begins on **Ash Wednesday** and ends at the Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday. Lent is traditionally observed by Catholics and some Protestant denominations, and comes from the Anglo Saxon word *lencten*, which means "spring." The key to understanding the meaning of Lent is simple: **Baptism**. Preparation for those being baptized (catechumens), those being confirmed (candidates) and for those renewing their baptismal commitment, lies at the heart of the season. The forty days represents the time Jesus spent in the wilderness, enduring the temptation of Satan and preparing to begin his ministry. For Catholics, Lent is a time of **prayer, fasting, almsgiving**, repentance and preparation for the coming of **Easter**. Today, Christians focus on their relationship with God, often choosing to give up something or to volunteer and give of themselves for others. Our challenge at this time is to renew our relationship with the Lord Jesus and with one another, as we make our way to the Kingdom of heaven.
